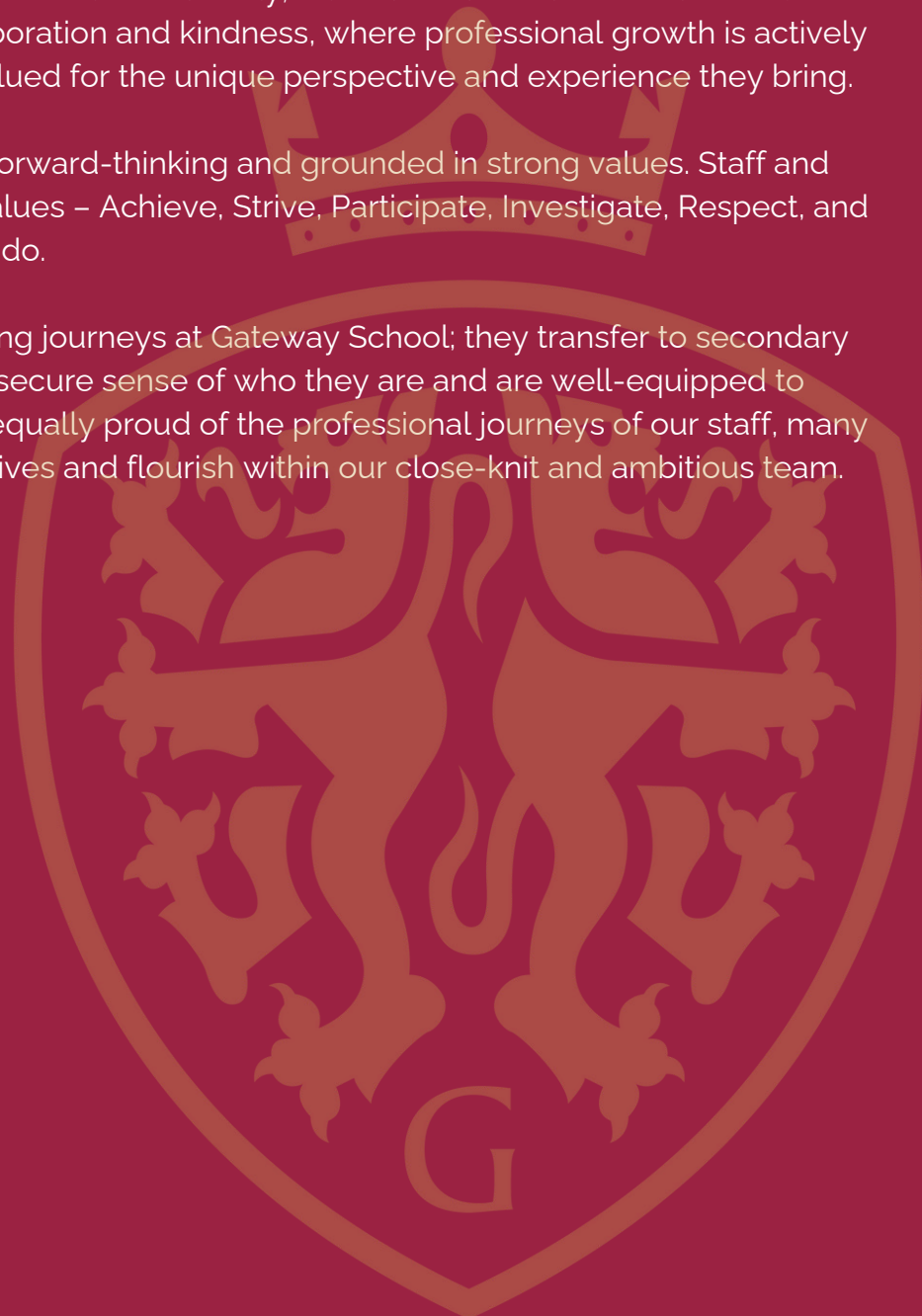

Duties and Responsibilities

- Driving a school Minibus or other vehicle on designated routes or as directed.
- Responsible for the safety, comfort and welfare of the pupils to and from school at all times.
- Carry out driver's daily and weekly vehicle checks, and to carry out basic maintenance.
- Report any vehicle defects, faults, incidents and accidents to the Estates Manager.
- Be responsible for the cleanliness of vehicles, and ensuring the vehicle is in a clean and roadworthy condition before and after use.
- Refuel vehicles as required.
- Maintain and help to promote a good company image, working attire should be worn at all times and kept in a clean and tidy condition.
- Work within health and safety guidelines and other guidelines that may be issued from time-to-time
- Take responsibility for the health and safety of the school vehicle and users
- Attend relevant training courses as identified and agreed, this will include Minibus Driver Awareness Scheme.
- First Aid at work one day appointed person training
- The postholder's responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young persons for whom s/he is responsible, or with whom s/he comes into contact will be to adhere to and ensure compliance with the Schools Safeguarding Policy statement at all times.
- If, in the course of carrying out the duties of the post the postholder becomes aware of any actual or potential risks to the safety or welfare of children in the school s/he must report any concerns to his/her Line Manager or the School's Safeguarding Lead.
